**Two Day Show: Saturday, August 31st, 10 a.m.-6 p.m.
Sunday, September 1st, 10 a.m.-6 p.m.**

1. Each vendor is required to list all items that will be sold in each booth. All items will be approved on a case-by-case basis. If you sell an item that is not listed, you may be asked to remove the item. If you refuse to cooperate, your booth(s) will be closed and you will be asked to leave. Gross violators of this rule will be eliminated from future participation. The Chamber reserves the exclusive right to use its event logos on products. Violators of this rule may be removed from participation.
2. **The Following items will not be offered by any exhibitor.**
 - No guns will be permitted
 - No fireworks (Including snap pops, blaster balls, smoke/stink bombs, string pops, champagne poppers, etc.)
 - No cigarettes of any kind
 - No profane or obscene items of any kind (These include T-shirts, caps, buttons, pictures, key chains, etc.)
 - No drug paraphernalia
 - No toys with sharp ends
 - No live animals, including turtles
 - No automatic knives, switchblades, or butterfly/balisong knives
 - ❖ (Handmade fixed blade, fixed blade, manual, handmade manual knives, and cutlery knives are acceptable)
 - ❖ **MUST** have sign stating all knives must remain packaged until off festival premise.
 - The sale of anything that may prove harmful
3. All entries received by August 12, 2019, are \$75. If you sell goat related items, you will receive a 50% discount on your booth fee. Applicants must send signed entry form and payment by Cashiers Check, Money Order, or Personal Check. We also accept MasterCard/Visa. After August 12th the entry goes up to \$100 for all vendors.
4. Returning vendors have until March 15, 2019, to return their entry forms to ensure they keep the same booth space. After March 15, remaining spaces will become available to all other vendors.
5. Applicant must furnish their own backdrops, tables, chairs, fans, extension cords, etc.
6. Vehicle passes and wristbands will be mailed with confirmation letters. Each entry is allowed **1 (one) vehicle pass** and **2 (two) wristbands**. Additional weekend passes may be purchased for \$5 on entry form only. The pass allows you into the park for set up and then vehicles must be moved out to vendor parking. If you park in General Admission parking, your vehicle will be towed.
7. Vendor set up/check in will begin Saturday at 6:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Any vendor not checked in by 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, August 31, 2019, will not be admitted into the festival. No refunds.
8. On Saturday, your booth must be set up by 10:00 a.m. and your vehicle moved to vendor parking. Your vehicle **MUST BE** moved to vendor parking so that we can maintain fire lanes within the park. This will be strictly enforced and violating vehicles will be removed.
9. If you have to restock from your trailer or vehicle during festival hours, please be prepared to do so yourself with a dolly. Vehicles will only be allowed back into the fair area after the completion of the event for loading.
10. NO four wheelers, bicycles, golf carts, motorized scooters, mules, etc. allowed. No exceptions will be made, regardless of circumstance.
11. **Arts and Crafts booths will open at 10:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday to the public. Please make sure to bring enough goods to display for the entire time. Exhibitors must keep their booths open until 6:00 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.**
12. **Please be advised, if you are closing your booth down early, you will not be allowed to break down or bring your vehicle in until after the festival closes at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.**
13. You are responsible for having and displaying a valid sales tax number and for collecting and submitting sales tax to the State of Texas Comptroller. The Brady/McCulloch County Chamber of Commerce is NOT responsible for collecting or submitting your sales tax. If sale tax is included in price, please have sign stating so. Tax ID number **MUST BE SUBMITTED ON FORM.**
14. All food items must be prepared in an approved, State inspected kitchen and have ingredient label on their products.
15. You are responsible for the cleanliness of your space. Any space left in disarray or with loose trash/garbage will disqualify you from future participation.
16. No firearms will be allowed in the Arts/Crafts area. Violators will be asked to leave the area and banned from participation.
17. Gambling is not allowed in the Arts/Crafts area. Violators will be banned from participation.
18. The Vendor Committee shall be the final authority on interpretation of the rules, regulations, and selection of exhibitors. The Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to reject any vendor and/or require the booth to be closed. Acceptance or non-acceptance will not be discussed over the phone by festival staff.

- 19. The Brady/McCulloch County Chamber of Commerce shall not be responsible for any accidents, lost, stolen or damaged property, or hurt feelings.
- 20. Any and all parking violators will be towed at owner's expense. Please adhere to all rules for the safety of our vendors, contestants, and patrons.
- 21. NO REFUNDS----RAIN OR SHINE----No exceptions, regardless of circumstance.

The Brady/McCulloch County Chamber of Commerce is now accepting entries for the 42nd Annual Arts and Crafts Fair at the World Championship Barbeque Goat Cook Off to be held on Saturday, August 31st and Sunday, September 1st at Richards Park in Brady, Texas.

We are committed to bringing quality vendors and entertainment each year to our event and would like to extend an invitation to you to participate. The show has been changed from a one day show to a two-day show, and with that the entry fee has changed. Vendors with goat related items for sale in their booths will also receive a 50% discount on their entry fee. The more goat, the better! We've moved the dance from the square to the park, so this should help keep visitors in the park after the winners are announced!

If you wish to add a spot this year, you will be able to do so when empty spots become available to the general public on Tuesday, March 18th. Please contact our office at that time to process those requests. We will make every effort to accommodate you.

We have also enclosed the Goat Cook-Off grounds map for your reference. Please keep in mind that this map is not drawn to scale and simply serves as an approximate guide for booth locations within the park. While some sites may *appear* larger than others, rest assured the grounds crew will mark all spots appropriately.
